## **Welcome to today's service!**

On Palm Sunday we traditionally remember how, before that first Easter, the crowds outside Jerusalem hailed Jesus as the 'Son of David' - the long-awaited Messiah - and praised him as he entered Jerusalem, laying palm leaves on the road before him, celebrating his arrival as a victory parade. This morning, though, continuing our focus on the Creed, we're fast-forwarding a few days to the time when the very same crowds had turned on him and called out instead for his crucifixion. The Son of God himself was spat on, mocked, flogged, and then taken out to be executed.

Every time I come to this part of our history, it shocks me and makes me face up to how fickle we are as people. Even now, when our sporting heroes take to the field, we cheer for them, but if they appear not to meet up to our expectations, how quickly our newspapers tear them apart (and how easily we do the same!). In this case, though, the irony is that — even if they missed it at the time — Jesus' entry into Jerusalem did actually result in the greatest victory the world has ever seen: the victory that God won for us over death. We really do have every reason to sing 'Hosanna'... 'Our God saves'!
